Excellency,

I have the honour to inform that the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco is offering **fifteen (15) scholarships** for Indonesian students who wish to study in Moroccan state centers for higher education and training during the 2009-2010 academic year.

I have the further honour to enclose herewith, for your attention and for the candidates use 1 CD listing the educational and training centers (along with the access prerequisites, the centers available, the studies duration and the degrees and diplomas delivered by the latter), a candidate's application form, an example of the candidates' list and a list of Moroccan Universities. The procedure as to the prerequisites and documents to attach to the application form for access to the scholarships, as enclosed herewith, remain the same as for the previous academic year.

Nevertheless, **All applicants should note that:**

- The deadline for submitting the scholarship applications to the Moroccan Agency for International Cooperation (AMCI) is **10 August 2009**;
- Only the applications pre-selected by the relevant Indonesian authorities and forwarded through the usual diplomatic channel will be accepted;
- A name-list of the pre-selected candidates should accompany the candidates' files;
- Indonesian diplomats and residents in Morocco as well as their spouses and children may register, without scholarships and off the official channel, in the higher education centers listed in the enclosed CD;
- **French** is the teaching language in most Moroccan educational centers, more especially in those imparting scientific and technical learning;
- Applicants who wish to register for **Islamic studies or the Arab language and literature** should know that mastering the Arabic language is a key prerequisite.
